A solution needed to be found that delivered flawless mobile connectivity on all four mobile networks through the building. This would ensure the building delivered a peerless experience for its tenants.

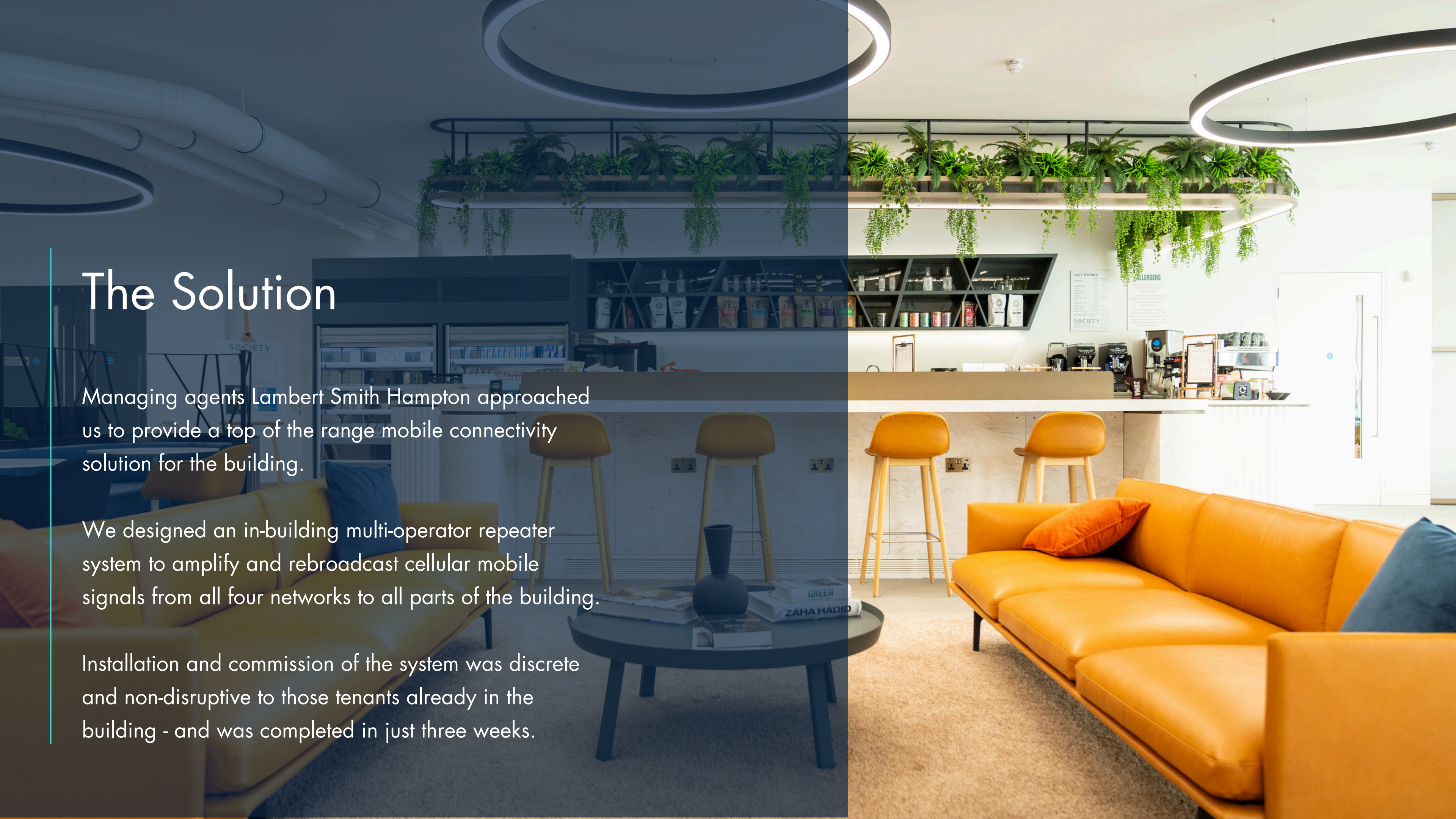


# The Solution

Installation and commission of the system was discrete and non-disruptive to those tenants already in the building - and was completed in just three weeks.
